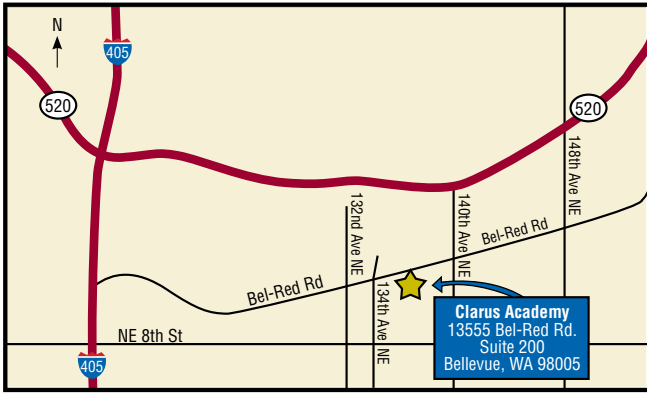


Clarus Academy

ELLIOTT'S CHESS SCHOOL. Using video curriculum developed by National Master Elliott Neff, this program utilizes the new Chess4Life model where students develop critical thinking skills as they advance through multiple levels and track their individual progress.

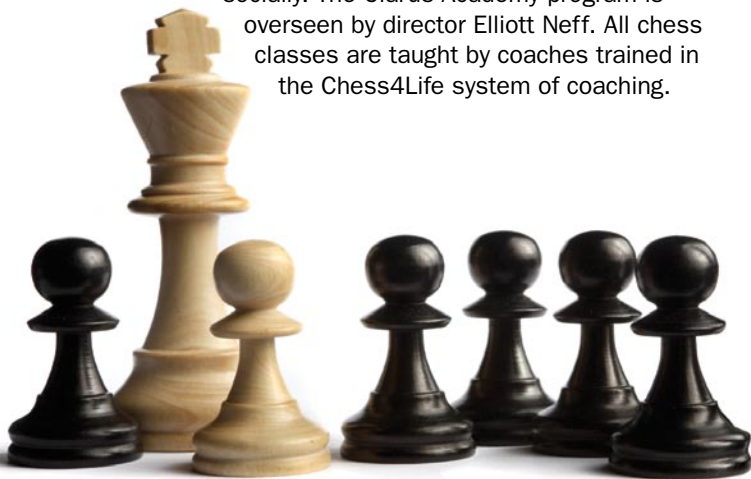
HOMEWORK TIME AND ASSISTANCE. Qualified teachers and staff will oversee your child's homework time and offer direction when needed.

CHARACTER BUILDING PROGRAM. This fun program is offered each week by a trained and qualified instructor. The half-hour classes are designed to help develop 49 important character qualities and social skills such as attentiveness, responsibility, and cooperation.

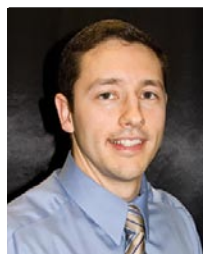
