Student Health Homework Agreement

2009-2010 School Year

Students who consistently complete and turn in homework assignments perform significantly better in academics than those of similar ability that do not. Homework is useful to reinforce what the student learns in class, prepare for upcoming lessons, develop responsibility, and help form positive study habits. Keeping this in mind, Clarus Academy provides assistance to students concerning the completion of their assigned work.

What Clarus Academy Will Provide:

Time will be set aside on a daily basis specifically for homework, as well as a quiet environment so students can focus on their studies. Our staff will be available to the students to encourage and guide their studies where needed. The Clarus staff will also offer helpful feedback on the student's homework to double check work and completeness of assignments. Necessary supplies for homework will be readily available to students, such as calculators, writing materials, research materials, coloring supplies and measuring tools.

Student's Homework Responsibilities:

Students should do their best job on their homework. It is expected that homework will be neat and the student gives each assignment their best effort before asking for help from Clarus Staff. Students should be honest with the Staff about any homework assignments or projects they are working on. To best assist our students, any homework schedule provided by the teacher should be copied at the academy for our records.

Parent/Guardian Support:

It is imperative for parents to communicate with their student, teachers, and the Clarus Staff about homework assignments. At any point which homework problems become evident, timely contact with the staff should be established through the e-mail address afterschool@chess4life.com. Failure to communicate with the staff will adversely affect the ability of the staff to help your student succeed academically. It is helpful when discussing homework with a student, to listen in a careful and non-judgmental manner to avoid nagging and to brainstorm solutions for overcoming difficulties. To best support your students please take the time to explain what your expectations are.

If Students Do Not Complete Homework:

Students will be encouraged to ask the Clarus Staff about any aspect of their work they do not understand. If a student forgets their homework, or chooses not to do their homework, they will forfeit participation in Enrichment Activities for the week and have to complete their forgotten or unattended assignments during those periods of time. During the week which problems occur, if a student has no additional homework to complete during these times, reading and work related to current studies will be assigned. If the problem persists a meeting will take place to discuss possible solutions.
