Akobian is an Armenian-born chess Grandmaster with a USCF rating of 2652, and a FIDE rating of 2600. At only age 5 he began playing chess, and in 1999, he earned the National Master title at the age of 15. In 2003, he became a FIDE International Grandmaster.

Currently, GM Akobian studies chess approximately 25 hours per week, trains with weights and exercises for about 7 hours weekly, coaches students, maintains his website, writes articles for chess publications, gives simultaneous exhibitions, and still he finds time to compete in and win major chess events around the world.
