MATH SPECIALITY CAMPS

Introduction to Fractions, Decimals, and Percentages — An intro course designed for younger students new to fractions and decimals.

Advanced Fractions, Decimals, and Percentages — Focuses on adding, subtracting, multiply and dividing fractions and decimals.

Word Problems — Designed to teach students how to analyze both single and multi-step word problems in order to figure out the appropriate mathematical operations to use. At a minimum, students should be proficient in 3-digit addition and subtraction as well as knowing their multiplication and division tables.

ENGLISH SPECIALTY CAMPS

Creative Writing — Focuses on the basic elements of creative writing, specifically characterization and plot development. Students will write three short stories as well as complete exercises on character development and plot development.

Essay Writing — designed to teach students how to write the five basic types of essays (compare and contrast, informative, persuasive, descriptive, and process). Emphasizes the importance of outlining and rough drafts as major elements of the writing process.

Vocabulary Improvement — designed to help students improve their vocabulary through the understanding of various prefixes, suffixes, and root words. Students will learn how to reason out the approximate meaning of words through their context as well as through the understanding of their component parts.
