\$110 for the 10-session quarter.

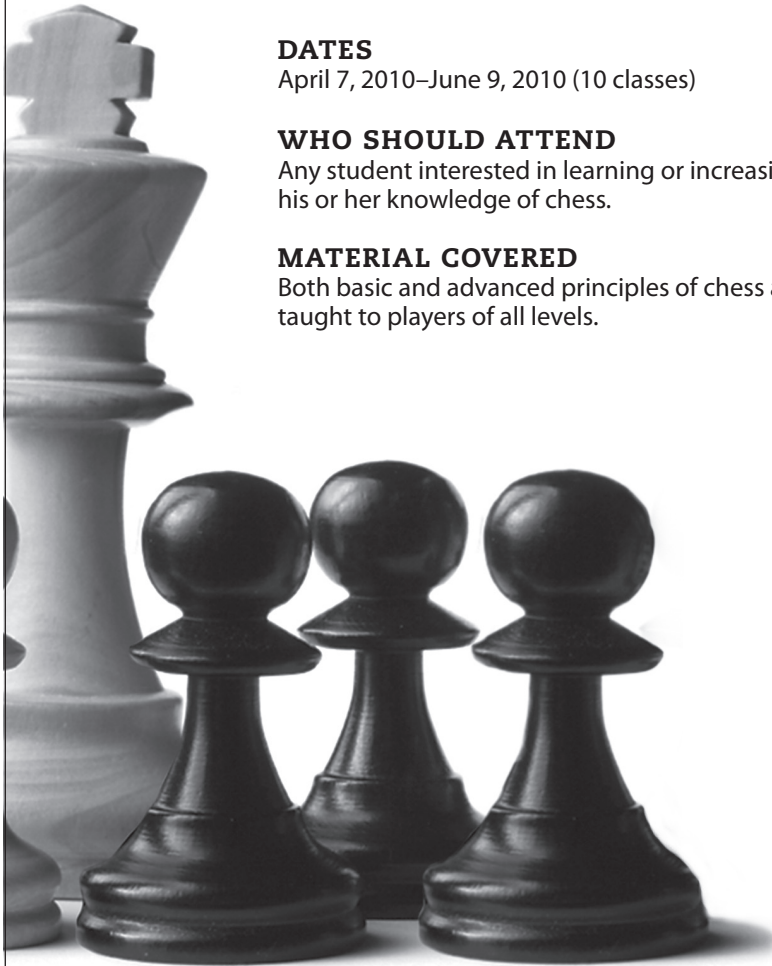
